



Snap on SMILE

The revolutionary Snap-On-Smile appliance is a removable cosmetic device for smile enhancement. The appliance is made of plastic much similar to the newer 'plastic' or tooth shaded fillings — but is custom made to fit the patient. Changes in size, shape, contour and positioning of the teeth is usually possible within certain guidelines and limitations of the material itself and the size, shape and position of the teeth that the device will 'snap onto'.



To have a Snap-on-Smile, impressions or moulds are taken of a patient's upper and lower teeth and the way their upper and lower teeth come together (bite relationship) and from this a custom made removable cosmetic appliance is fabricated.

It's easy to put in and easy to take out—and makes a brand new Smile instantly.

It is not unusual that a patient may experience some 'soreness' to the teeth for the first several days after wearing the appliance. This is a similar effect as to if orthodontics or 'braces' were being used — and this 'soreness' usually diminishes within a couple of days.

After some practice, a patient wearing the Snap-On-Smile can usually eat much as if not wearing the device; being aware that the device is, after all, 'plastic' and subject to breakage or damage if treated improperly or trying to eat 'too hard' of food. Being plastic it is also subject to staining like 'plastic' fillings could undergo stain with certain foods like coffee, tea, berries and with habits such as smoking.

This appliance is not intended to be a procedure or treatment for repair of the teeth due to decay (caries). It is suggested that a patient remove the appliance and brush their teeth after each meal or snack (if possible) and clean the appliance as well. In addition to very good home care and oral hygiene, supplemental use of fluoride gels or rinses are recommended. This device is not intended to be worn 24 hrs a day—but only during periods of time when smile enhancement is desired. It should never be worn at night or during sleep.
